**LONG RANGE REGIONAL MATCH – NRA REGISTERED**

**DATE:** Sat. April 30, 2005, Palma® Individual, Iron Sight (firing time: 7:30 am)(entries close 7:15 am)  
Sat. April 30, 2005, 1,000 yd Individual, Palma Rifle, Iron Sight (after Palma® Individual)  
Sun. May 1, 2005, Palma® Individual, Iron Sight (firing time: 7:30am)(entries close 7:15 am)  
Sun. May 1, 2005, 1,000 yd 4-Man Team, Any Rifle, Any Sight (1:00 pm approximately)

**LOCATION:** The Winnequah Gun Club range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison, and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). Continue north on J to the CTY HWY V (1.2 miles) intersection, turn west (left) on CTY HWY V to Lang Road (0.3 miles), turn right. Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles. Camping is permitted and the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday, April 29 for those who wish to stay overnight.

**RULES:** Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Long Range Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

**SAFETY:** For the safety of the pit crew, a competitor who fails to get on target in **TEN SHOTS** may be directed to stop firing. For purposes of this rule, an oblong hole from a ricochet does NOT count as a hit. **All sighting shots must be scored on back of score card!**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to any individual member of the NRA or a member of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club. Teams will consist of four members. An alternate and non-firing captain and coach may also be named, or the captain and coach may be firing members of the team. A team captain **MUST** be named (Rule 12.1). Team representation Club-Rule 2.11; Law Enforcement Agency-Rule 2.14; Service-Rule 2.13; State Association-Rule 2.12; or Junior-Rule 2.18.

**EQUIPMENT:**

- Individual Matches: Palma® rifle-Rule 3.3.3. Sights: metallic only Rule 3.7(a). Use of Palma® rifle for entire match is required for Palma® Team tryout qualification.
- Service Rifle – Rule 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 (includes .223 Rem)
- 1,000 yd Matches: Palma Rifle, Iron sight-Rule 3.2.
- Team Match: Any rifle-Rule 3.2. Sights: Any sight – Rule 3.7(c).
- “F” Class – competitors may use sand bag or bipod rests (from the ground), no bench rests allowed. Any rifle, caliber .34 or smaller (no muzzle brakes allowed) may be used. There are no restrictions on sights.
- AROS – any rifle, optics, sling: separate category from “F” class; **NO** sandbags, other rests or muzzle brakes allowed.

**ENTRIES:** Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Long Range classification, NRA membership number and email address. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament. Confirmations will be sent by email. **IF YOU ARE NOT CHECKED IN AT THE STAT OFFICE 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRING TIME, YOUR SPOT WILL BE GIVEN TO A PERSON ON THE WAITING LIST.** Mail individual entry form with correct fees, and team entry form only to:

Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (66) until April 27. Entries received after April 27 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee. Squadding preference will be given to entries for both days.

Team entries must be made at the Stat Office by the Team Captain before 12:45 pm May 1, 2005- limited to 22 teams. **DO NOT MAIL IN TEAM FEES - ENTRY FORM ONLY! TEAM FEES MUST BE PAID BY TEAM CAPTAIN AT THE STAT OFFICE!!**

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Statistical Office. **Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing each day.** NRA Long Range classification and membership cards must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event. Squadding for the Team Match will be drawn by the Team Captain when registration is completed.

**COURSE OF FIRE (competitors will score and pull targets)** Long Range targets will be used at 800, 900, 1000 yards.

Saturday, April 30: Match 1 - Palma® Individual, 15 shots each at 800, 900, 1000 yds; 22 minutes each stage (unlimited sighters at 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900, 1000 yds)  
Match 2(pm) - Individual, 20 shots 1000 yds; 30 minutes (unlimited sighters)(Palma Rifle-Iron Sight)  
Sunday, May 1: Match 3 - Palma® Individual, 15 shots each at 800, 900, 1000 yds; 22 minutes each stage (unlimited sighters 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900, 1000 yds)  
Match 4 - Regional Championship, Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, and 3  
Match 5 (pm) - 4-Man Team Match (Any Rifle/Any Sight), 20 shots each firing member; two 63 minute time periods/team (unlimited sighters)

**CATEGORIES AND CLASSES:** Separate class and aggregate awards will be given for civilian service rifle and service rifle if there are more than 5 competitors in each category. There will be no separate categories in the Match Rifle Division. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place awards will be given only if there are 5, 10, 15 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than the required number of entries in a class to provide awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category. If there are still fewer than 5 entries after combining all categories, there will be NO AWARDS in that class, and all competitors in the lower class will be moved back to their respective category in the next higher class, until there are a minimum of 5 competitors in the combined class.

**SPECIAL AWARDS CATEGORIES:** An award will be given to the High Woman, High Senior (Rule 2.2.1), High Junior (Rule 2.3) (Match 4). A special award will be given if there are three or more teams using a Service Rifle or Palma® rifle (all team members must use same type of rifle to be eligible)(Match 5).

- “F” Class competitors will compete only among themselves and **ARE NOT** eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches. Awards in the “F” Class will be made based upon the number of “F” Class competitors (5 or more) in that match.
- AROS competitors will compete only among themselves and **ARE NOT** eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches. Awards in AROS will be made based upon the number of competitors (5 or more) in that match.
