TRIPLE CROWN REGIONAL MATCH (NRA REGISTERED)

DATE: Sat. May 28, 2005, 50 shot 4-Man Team Match (firing time: 10:00 am)(entries close at 9:30 am)
Sun. May 29, 2005, 100 shot Individual Match (firing time: 7:30 am)(entries close 7:15 am)

LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun Club range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). Continue north on J to the CTY HWY V (1.2 miles) intersection, turn west (left) on CTY HWY V to Lang Road (0.3 miles), turn right. Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles. Camping is permitted and the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday, May 27 for those who wish to stay overnight.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the NRA or a member of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club. Teams will consist of four members. An alternate and non-firing captain and coach may also be named, or the captain and coach may be firing members of the team. A team captain **MUST** be named (Rule 12.1). Team representation Club-Rule 2.11; Law Enforcement Agency-Rule 2.14; Service-Rule 2.13; State Association-Rule 2.12; or Junior-Rule 2.18.

EQUIPMENT:

- NRA Match Rifle-Rule 3.3. Metallic sights only will be used – Rule 3.7(a).
- Service Rifle - Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 (includes .223 Rem)
- There will be two divisions: NRA Match Rifle and Service Rifle.

ENTRIES: Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA National Match Course classification, NRA membership number and email address. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament. Confirmations will be sent by email. **IF YOU ARE NOT CHECKED IN AT THE STAT OFFICE 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRING TIME, YOUR SPOT WILL BE GIVEN TO A PERSON ON THE WAITING LIST.** Mail individual entry form with correct fees, and team entry form only to:

Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (88) until May 25. Entries received after May 25 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee.

Team entries must be made at the Stat Office by the **Team Captain** before 9:30 am May 28, 2004 - limited to 22 teams. **DO NOT MAIL IN TEAM FEES - ENTRY FORM ONLY! TEAM FEES MUST BE PAID BY TEAM CAPTAIN AT THE STAT OFFICE!!**

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Statistical Office. **Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing each day.** NRA National Match Course classification and membership cards must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event. Squadding for the Team Match will be drawn for by the Team Captain when registration is completed.

May 28 – 4 Man Team Match
(50 shots/person, 2 sighters/position) COACHING ALLOWED!
Targets: 200 yards-SR; 300 yards-SR3; 600 yards-MR-1

Match 1: 4-Man Team Match: The National Match Course (competitors will score and pull targets)

- 10 shots standing, slow fire, 200 yards
- 10 shots sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, 200 yards
- 10 shots prone from standing, rapid fire, 300 yards
- 20 shots prone, slow fire, 600 yards.

May 29-Individual (100 shot Regional course, starting at 600 yards)(competitors will score and pull targets)

- Match 2: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, prone slow fire, 600 yd, Rule 5.6
Match 3: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, prone slow fire, 600 yd, Rule 5.6
Match 4: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, prone rapid fire, 300 yd, Rule 5.6
Match 5: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, standing slow fire, 200 yd, Rule 5.12 (Matches 1 and 2 will be fired consecutively for efficient running of match.)
Match 6: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, sitting/kneeling rapid fire, 200 yd, Rule 5.8 or 5.10
Match 7: Slow Fire Aggregate: scores fired in Matches 2,3,5
Match 8: Rapid Fire Aggregate: scores fired in Matches 4 and 6
Match 9: Regional Championship: scores fired in Matches 2,3,4,5,6

CATEGORIES AND CLASSES: Separate class and aggregate awards will be given for civilian service rifle and service rifle if there are more than 5 competitors in each category. There will be no separate categories in the Match Rifle Division. Civilian competitors will be eligible under Rule 2.5, 2.6 and 2.7. 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards will be given only if there are 5, 10, 15 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than the required number of entries in a class to provide awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category. If there are still fewer than 5 entries after combining all categories, there will be NO AWARDS in that class, and all competitors in the lower class will be moved back to their respective category in the next higher class, until there are a minimum of 5 competitors in the combined class.

SPECIAL AWARDS CATEGORIES: An award will be given to the High Woman, High Senior (Rule 2.2.1), High Junior (Rule 2.3) (Match 8). A special award will be given if there are three or more teams using a Service Rifle (all team members must use same type of rifle to be eligible)(Match 9).

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CREDIT AWARD: The highest shooter in each class (**providing there are a minimum of 5 shooters in that classification in the Grand Aggregate**) will receive \$40.00 credit toward entry fees to Camp Perry for this discipline. The credit is valid for 13 months and is **NOT TRANSFERABLE**. An individual may win more than one credit within a "Camp Perry year", but cannot exceed entry fees. A total of only 5 credits will be given. A credit will be given to the highest High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter and Marksman (min. 5 competitors each) without regard to category (**no combining of classes**). The overall winner of the Regional will win a credit regardless of the number of competitors in his/her class if not in a class with 5 shooters in it.
