DIRECTIONS:

Take U.S. Highway 41-141 North of Green Bay to Brown County Trunk "B" (exit 176, Sunset Beach Road., Suamico Exit, [New Zoo], etc. This is approximately five (5) miles North of Tower Drive (Interstate 43). Exit onto County Trunk "B" and head west on "B" (left at the stop sign and pass under Hwy 41-141). You will come to a four-way stop sign at the intersection of County Trunks "HS" & "B", also known as the intersection of Sunset Beach [or School] Rd. And Velp Ave. Continue West on "B" for 9/10 mile, just past the Suamico Elementary School (on your left), and turn left onto Riverside Drive. The turn is **before** you cross the railroad tracks. Proceed South on Riverside Drive for 3/10 mile to the intersection with St. Pat's Drive. (It comes from the right, **only**). Turn right onto St. Pat's Dr. (West) and proceed, crossing the tracks, for 9/10 mile. The range is in the woods, on the right, just before the road curves sharply left. For those of you with GPS, the coordinates of our gate are N44°38.062" -W88°05.314".

ELIGIBILITY:

All competitors must provide a completed and **notarized** Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement unless we already have one on file from a previous State Garand Match. A notary public will be present for those of you requiring such services.

COMPETITION:

Competition is open to members of the National Rifle Association of the United States who are also members of **either** *The Wisconsin Rifle & Pistol Association* or the Rifle & Pistol Association of their legal State of Residence. *WR&PA* membership applications will be available at the range.

ENTRY FEE:

The entry fee is \$35.00 per entry and includes issue ball ammunition, and the appropriate fees to both NRA & WR&PA.

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Entries close when range capacity is filled (Eighty [80] Competitors.)
PRE-REGISTRATION AND PRE-PAYMENT ARE REQUIRED!!!

FIRING STARTS:

The first relay will commence firing at 9:00 a.m. **central time**. The second relay will commence firing at approximately 10:30 a.m. **Any entrant who does not show up to claim his assigned firing position at least fifteen (15) minutes before scheduled firing commences shall forfeit his reservation for that relay and/or point.**

RULES:

Current Civilian Marksmanship Program John Garand Match rules shall apply. These are 50-round matches and will be fired using **As-Issued U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M1903 Springfield, M1917 Enfield, caliber .30 M-1 Garand, M1941 Johnson and U.S. Carbine, Caliber .30 M1.**

a) These firearms shall be "as-issued" by the U.S. armed forces or a commercially manufactured rifle of the same type and caliber, having not less than a 4.5 pound trigger pull, with standard stock and leather or web sling. Rifles must conform to the weight and dimensions of the standard issue service rifle, and only U.S. Government issue parts or commercial parts of the exact same weight and dimensions may be used. Rifles may be accurized only by the careful assembly of standard parts.

b) Rebarreling with a barrel of "as-issued" dimensions is permitted. No other modification or alteration of the "as-issued" rifle, such as glass bedding, the fitting of NM parts or the use of synthetic stocks is permitted. Sights must be as issued with no alterations as to height, thickness or size of aperture. No "peening or gluing of parts is allowed.

c) No rifles chambered for the 7.62mm NATO (.308) cartridge may be used.

d) Only the ammunition furnished by the sponsor may be fired in this match.

e) Eye and hearing protection are mandatory. Contact lenses **do not** qualify as eye protection.

f) NRA chamber flags are mandatory. If you do not have one, you may purchase one from the statistical officer.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

This is a John Garand Match, Course B. All firing is done at 200 Yards on NRA target SR. Five minutes of sighters, no more than 5 shots total will precede the first stage of record firing.

STAGE 1: SLOW PRONE, 20 ROUNDS IN 20 MINUTES.
STAGE 2: RAPID, PRONE FROM STANDING, 10 ROUNDS IN 70 SECONDS.
STAGE 3: RAPID, SITTING FROM STANDING, 10 ROUNDS IN 60 SECONDS.
STAGE 4: SLOW FIRE, STANDING, 10 ROUNDS IN 10 MINUTES.

CLASSIFICATION:

NRA High Power Rifle (Conventional) Classification will be in effect.
