1200 YARD MATCH

DATE: Tuesday, June 21, 2005

TIME: 45 minutes after completion of the Palma® Team/Practise

ELIGIBILITY: Entry in the Midwest Palma® matches. The first 30 people who sign up will be eligible to compete in this match since there are only ten firing points at the 1200 yard line.

"F" CLASS: Competitors may use sandbags or bipod rests (from the ground), no bench rests or muzzle brakes allowed.

SQUADDING: Squadding will be done on the 1200 yard line. Each competitor will draw out of a hat for relay and firing point. Relay 1 will fire first; Relay 2 will score; Relay 3 will pull targets – then there will be a pit change. Relay 1 will go to the pits and pull targets for Relays 2 and 3. There will only be 15 minutes allowed for firing.

EQUIPMENT: No rifles smaller than 6mm, 100 grain bullet, and not less than 2700 feet per second (fps). **OPTICAL SIGHTS ONLY!**

FEES: \$10.00

COURSE OF FIRE: Unlimited practice firing, and 15 shots for record, 25 minutes.

AWARDS: There will be a traveling trophy awarded to the Match Winner; "F" class is not eligible for the Match Winner trophy. One-half of the entry fee will be given back to the competitors.
