**4-GUN 600 YD MATCH**

**NRA APPROVED**

**DATE:** Sunday, July 24, 2005 (entries close 7:30 am) (starts at 8:00 am)

**LOCATION:** The Winnequah Gun Club range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). Continue north on J to the CTY HWY V (1.2 miles) intersection, turn west (left) on CTY HWY V to Lang Road (0.3 miles), turn right. Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to any individual member of the NRA or a member of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club.

**RULES:** Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

**EQUIPMENT:**

- NRA Match Rifle – Rule 3.3, Iron Sight
- NRA Match Rifle – Any Sight, Rule 3.3.4
- Palma® Rifle – Rule 3.3.3, Iron Sight
- Palma® Rifle – Any Sight
- Any Rifle Iron Sight – Rule 3.7(a)(2)
- Any Rifle Any Sight – Rule 3.7(c)
- Service Rifle – Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 (inc. .223 Rem)
- "F" Class - competitors may use sandbag or bipod rests (from the ground), no bench rests allowed. Any rifle, caliber .34 or smaller (no muzzle brakes allowed) may be used. There are no restrictions on sights.
- AROS – any rifle, optics, sling: separate category from "F" class; **NO** sandbags, other rests or muzzle brakes allowed.

**ENTRIES:** Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Long Range classification, NRA membership number and email address. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry. **IF YOU ARE NOT CHECKED IN AT THE STAT OFFICE 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRING TIME, YOUR SPOT WILL BE GIVEN TO A PERSON ON THE WAITING LIST.** Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (88) until July 21. Entries received after July 21 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee. Confirmations will be sent by email if possible.

**FEES: (make checks payable to Winnequah Gun Club)**

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Statistical Office. **Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing that day.** NRA Long Range classification and membership cards must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event.

**COURSE OF FIRE: (all matches are 2 sighters and 20 shots for record)(competitors will score and pull targets)**

Stage 1: NRA Match Rifle/Palma® Rifle, Iron Sights  
Stage 2: NRA Match Rifle/Palma® Rifle, Any Sights  
Stage 3: Any Rifle, Any Sight  
Stage 4: Any Rifle, Iron Sight  
Match 5: Grand Aggregate (Stages 1,2,3,4)

**AWARDS:** Awards will be given to the individual Match Winners in each match. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place awards will be given only if there are 5, 10, 15 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than the required number of entries in a class to provide awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category.

**"F" CLASS COMPETITORS:** All individual events are open to participation by F-Class competitors. F-Class competitors will compete only among themselves and **ARE NOT** eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches. Awards in the F-Class will be made based upon the number of F-Class competitors in that Match.

**AROS-** Any Rifle, Optics, Sling: An award will be given for the highest AROS competitor provided five (5) or more are entered. AROS competitors are not eligible for the Match Winner.
