WISCONSIN STATE LONG RANGE 4-MAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

WR&PA APPROVED - NRA REGISTERED

DATE: Saturday, September 17, 2005- PALMA® Team (entries close: 8:00 a.m.)(starts at 8:30 a.m.)
Sunday, September 18, 2005 - 1,000 yd Team (entries close: 8:00 a.m.)(starts at 8:30 a.m.)

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A TEAM TO SHOOT WITH AND WANT TO BE PUT ON A WAITING LIST, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE STAT OFFICER 7 DAYS BEFORE THE MATCH BEGINS!!!

LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun Club Range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison, and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). Continue north on J to the CTY HWY V (1.2 miles) intersection, turn west (left) on CTY HWY V to Lang Road (0.3 miles), turn right. Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles. Camping is permitted and the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday, September 16 for those who wish to stay overnight.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Long Range Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

SAFETY: For the safety of the pit crew, a competitor who fails to get on target in **TEN SHOTS** may be directed to stop firing. For purposes of this rule, an oblong hole from a ricochet does NOT count as a hit. **All sighting shots must be scored on back of score card!**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the NRA or a member of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club. Wisconsin residents must be members of the Wisconsin Rifle and Pistol Association. Residents of other states must be members of their home state association. Teams shall represent clubs affiliated with the NRA or military unit. At least three (3) individuals making up the four (4) member team must be from the same club or military unit. A nonresident member of a Wisconsin resident team must reside in a state adjacent to Wisconsin (Michigan, Illinois, Iowa, or Minnesota). The same applies to Junior teams.

EQUIPMENT:

- NRA Match Rifle unmodified .30-06 or .308 must be used for the PALMA® match.
- Service Rifle - Rule 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 (includes .223 Rem)
- Any safe centerfire rifle, 1,000 yard; muzzle brakes not allowed.
- Iron and Any sights - the iron sights may be either corrective or noncorrective (Rule 3.7).
- Any safe ammunition.

ENTRIES: **Team Captain** must verify that all members have filled out the Team registration form at the Stat Office **BEFORE** going to the firing line. If this is not done, the team will be disqualified. Be sure to indicate the correct NRA Long Range classification, NRA membership number and email address. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry. The team score cards will be given to the Team Captain only. **TEAM CAPTAIN** should mail attached team entry form and fees to:

DO NOT SEND IN INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES. THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE STAT OFFICE! Team entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (22) until September 16. Team entries received after September 17 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee. Confirmations will be sent by email.

ENTRY FEES:

PACKAGE ENTRY FEE FOR TEAMS FIRING BOTH DAYS:

SQUADDING: NRA Long Range classification and membership cards must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event. Squadding for the Team Match will be drawn for by the Team Captain when registration is completed.

ORDER OF FIRING:

- Saturday - **PALMA®**, iron sights only. All teams will assemble on the 800 yard line.
- Sunday - **1,000 yd**. All teams will assemble on the 1,000 yd line.
- Since all teams must fire the same sight on the same relay, the IRON sight stage will be fired first (weather permitting).

COURSE OF FIRE: COACHING IS ALLOWED. COACHES MAY BE FIRING OR NONFIRING MEMBERS OF A TEAM.

Match 1: (Saturday) PALMA® Match, unlimited sighters at 800 yd; 2 sighters at 900 & 1,000 yds; 15 shots for record, IRON SIGHTS; two 47 minute time periods/team.

Match 2: (Sunday) Unlimited sighters and 20 record shots with ANY RIFLE-IRON SIGHTS; two 63 minute time periods/team.

Match 3: (Sunday) Unlimited sighters and 20 record shots with ANY RIFLE-ANY SIGHTS; two 63 minute time periods/team.

Match 4: State Championship Aggregate (Matches 1,2,3): High Wisconsin Resident Team will be declared the Wisconsin Long Range State Champion.

Match 5: Legislative Fund: High team score from 1,000 yd PALMA® Team Match.

AWARDS: Only Wisconsin residents are eligible to win the State Champion award. Only Wisconsin resident teams, including the current year's WI State Service Rifle Team, competing with service rifles, shall be eligible to win the Wisconsin State Champion Team award. Appropriate recognition will be given to the overall winning team and to the high team in each class for Match 1 (Palma Aggregate-Sat.), 2 (Any Iron-Sun.), 3 (Any Any-Sun), 4 (St. Champ. Agg.-1,2,3) and 5 (Legislative Fund 1,000 yd-Sat.). If less than three teams in a class are entered, they will be combined with the next higher class. If there are three or more all Junior teams, an appropriate award will be given. Second place awards in each class will be given if there are five or more teams in a class.

Special individual awards will be given for Matches 1, 2 and 3, HIGH INDIVIDUAL AND HIGH INDIVIDUAL SERVICE RIFLE, provided that five or more shooters use the service rifle throughout the match. HIGH INDIVIDUAL and HIGH INDIVIDUAL SERVICE RIFLE, provided five or more shooters use the service rifle for Match 1 (PALMA®). If a nonresident team is the Match Winner, an appropriate award will be given but they cannot be declared the Wisconsin State Champion.

NOTE: Must fire both days to compete for the Long Range Team State Championship. Each team will be allowed only one substitution from one day to another. If a substitution changes the Team's classification, the Team must compete in the higher classification for both days.
