NRA REGISTERED **9th ANNUAL MIDWEST PALMA® CHAMPIONSHIP**

DATE: June 16, 2008 – Palma® 4-Man Team Match or Individual Practise (fired concurrently)(close 8:30 am)(starts 9:00)
June 17, 2008 – Palma® Individual Match (entries close 7:30 am)(starts 8:00 am); 1200 yd Match (pm)
June 18, 2008 – Palma® Individual Match (entries close 7:30 am)(starts 8:00 am); 2-Man Team, 900 yd (pm)
June 19, 2008 – Palma® Individual Match (entries close 7:30 am)(starts 8:00 am); 2-Man Team, 1000 yd (pm)
June 20, 2008 – Three 1,000 yd Individual Matches (entries close 7:30 am)(starts 8:00 am)

LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun Club Range, approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison, and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). **New Entrance: Continue on J and V approximately one mile. Continue on Cty Hwy V approximately ¼ mile to the new Indoor Range building on the left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the new road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. Signs will be posted.** Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles. Camping is permitted and the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on June 15.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Long Range Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

SAFETY: For the safety of the pit crew, a competitor who fails to get on target in **TEN SHOTS** may be directed to stop firing. For purposes of this rule, an oblong hole from a ricochet does NOT count as a hit. All sighting shots must be scored on back of score card! **Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is shouldered and pointed towards the target.**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any member of the NRA. Juniors may be a member of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club. Teams will consist of four members.

EQUIPMENT:

Individual Matches: Palma® rifle - Rule 3.3.3. Sights: Metallic only – Rule 3.7(a).
Individual Matches: Service rifle – Rule 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 (includes .223 Rem).
1,000 yd Matches: Any rifle iron sight - Rule 3.2.
1,000 yd Matches: Palma® rifle – Any sight
1,000 yd Matches: Any rifle – Rule 3.2. Sights: Any sight – Rule 3.7(c)
Palma® 4-Man Team: Palma® rifle – Rule 3.3.3. Sights: Metallic sight – Rule 3.7(a).
“F” Class: See Rule 3.4 in NRA International Fullbore Prone Rifle Rules.
AROS: Any rifle, optics, sling: separate category from “F” class; **NO** sandbags, other rests or muzzle brakes allowed. **If shooting in the AROS category, you must stay in this category for all matches.**
1200 yd match: No rifles smaller than 6mm, 100 grain bullet, and not less than 2700 feet per second (fps). **OPTICAL SIGHTS ONLY.**

ENTRIES: Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Long Range classification and NRA membership number. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry. **IF YOU ARE NOT CHECKED IN AT THE STAT OFFICE 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRING TIME, YOUR SPOT WILL BE GIVEN TO A PERSON ON THE WAITING LIST.** Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Across the board entries will take precedence over one day entries, and will be accepted up to range capacity (112) until June 11. Confirmations will be sent by email or US mail. Any entries received after June 11 will be considered late and charged a late entry fee. **If you cannot attend the match, please notify me immediately.**

TARGETS: The NRA International Fullbore Prone scoring system will be used. Sample cards will be given at registration. Long Range targets will be used at 800, 900, 1000 yd
"F" Class new targets will be used at 800, 900, 1000 yd – LR-FC

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Individual packets will be available for pick up at the Stat Office on Sunday, June 15. NRA Long Range classification and membership cards must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event. Squadding for the Team Match will be drawn by the Team Captain when registration is completed.

COURSE OF FIRE: (competitors will score and pull targets)

Monday, June 16 – 9:00 am (Team Captain must register by 8:30 am)

Palma® 4-Man Team Match and Individual Practice will start at the 800 yard line.

Match 1: Palma® 4-Man Team, 15 shots each firing member at 800, 900, 1,000 yds
Unlimited sighters at 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900 and 1,000 yds; two 47 minute time periods/match

Tuesday, June 17– 8:00 am

Match 2: Palma® Individual, 15 shots each at 800, 900, 1,000 yds; 22 minutes each match
Unlimited sighters at 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900 and 1,000 yds

Match 11: 1200 yd, unlimited practice firing, 15 shots for record, 25 minutes (**not included in Grand Aggregate**)

Wednesday, June 18 – 8:00 am

Match 3: Palma® Individual, 15 shots each at 800, 900, 1,000 yds; 22 minutes each match
Unlimited sighters at 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900 and 1,000 yds

Match 12: Two Man Team: 900 yds, 2 convertible sighters, 15 shots for record, 47 minutes (**1/2 hour after completion of Palma® match**)

Thursday, June 19 – 8:00 am

Match 4: Palma® Individual, 15 shots each at 800, 900, 1000 yds; 22 minutes each match
Unlimited sighters at 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900 and 1,000 yds

Match 13: 2-Man Team: 1,000 yds, 2 convertible sighters, 15 shots for record, 47 minutes (**1/2 hour after completion of Palma® match**)

Friday, June 20 – 8:00 am (PLEASE CIRCLE RIFLE USED ON SCORECARD)

Match 5: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, Any Sight, unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 6: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Any Rifle, Iron Sight, unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 7: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Any Rifle, Any Sight, unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 8: Palma® Aggregate only (Matches 2,3, 4)

Match 9: 1,000 yd Aggregate only (Matches 5,6,7)

Match 10: Midwest Palma® Match Championship Aggregate (Matches 8, 9)

A SPECIAL AWARD will be given to those competitors who use a Palma® Rifle with mettalic sights for Matches 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

AWARDS: 50% of the individual entry fees will be returned to the competitors in cash awards. Awards will be given if there are 5, 10, 15 or more competitors in a given match or class. If there are less than five individuals or three teams in a class, they will be combined with the next class, except for High Masters. Lower classes will not be combined with the High Master class. The Liebetrau Sighting Shot Aggregate will be for the 900 and 1,000 yd stages of each Palma® Individual Match (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday).

"F" CLASS COMPETITORS: All individual events are open to participation by F-Class competitors. F-Class competitors will compete only among themselves and **ARE NOT** eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches. Awards in the F-Class will be made based upon the number of F-Class competitors in that Match. A cash prize will be awarded at the Awards/Pig Roast for the highest F-Class competitor, provided there are five (5) or more F-Class competitors entered in both categories. If there are two (2) or more F-Class teams entered in the 4-Man Team match, an award will be given.

"AROS" – ANY RIFLE OPTICS SLING: A cash prize will be awarded at the Awards/Pig Roast for the highest AROS competitor provided five (5) or more competitors are entered. AROS competitors will compete only among themselves and **ARE NOT** eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches.

1200 YD MATCH – range capacity is 40 people. Please indicate on entry form if you plan to compete in this match. Appropriate awards will be given.

2-Man Team - this will be an extra match after completion of the Palma® Individual matches on Wednesday and Thursday for anyone who wishes to enter. A \$6.00 entry fee will be collected from each person and distributed among the winners. This match will not be squadded. Each two man team assemble on the 900 yd line (Wed) and the 1000 yd line (Thur) for payment of entry fee and score card.

PIG ROAST: A pig roast and Awards Ceremony will be held after the match on Friday, June 20, 2008. The cost for **noncompetitors** will be \$9.00; children under 12 \$6.00. Please **DO NOT** send in money with match entry fees. The money will be collected at the pig roast.
