**Dates:** September 30 through October 4, 2008. Firing will begin at 8:00 am each day.

**Location:** Winnequah Gun Club Range, Lodi, Wisconsin, USA. The range is located approximately three miles north of Lodi. Take I-90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison, and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). ***New Entrance: Continue on J and V approximately one mile. Continue on Cty Hwy V approximately ¼ mile to the new Indoor Range building on the left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the new road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. Signs will be posted.*** Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles.

**General Information:** There are three motels and 2 RV campgrounds in the vicinity of Lodi (see attached motel list). Make reservations early. Twelve camp sites are available on the range with electrical hookups only. Water may be available at the indoor range if necessary. **Entries:** Entries and fees must be mailed to Karin Liebetrau, 10890 Summit Ridge Drive, Viola WI 54664. We do not take credit cards. International competitors can pay their fees by cash or money order. Program will be available at [www.WRPA.com](http://www.WRPA.com) approximately January 14, 2008.

**Entry Closing Date and Fees:**

Advance entries are recommended. Entries close September 24, 2008, however, late entries may be accepted providing they do not exceed the range capacity (112). Late entry fee is \$25.00.

Individual entry fees: \$230.00 (if target pullers are provided Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday) \$150.00 (no target pullers Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday)  
\$80.00 for Juniors (\$160 if target pullers are provided)  
\$80.00 for the four man teams. Team entries must be made one hour prior to the match.  
Daily fees for Individuals: \$70.00 (\$90 if target pullers are provided).  
Match fees will cover part of the cost for target pullers.

The nontarget puller entry fees can be sent in with the entry form. This will guarantee your squadding. If target pullers are provided, additional fees will be collected when you check in at the Stat Office.

**Rules:** The NRA High Power Rifle Rules will be in effect for this match.

**Competitor Eligibility:** This competition is open to all individual NRA members. International competitors must join the USA National Rifle Association. Membership forms will be available at the Stat Office when checking in for the match. International Teams and Individuals are invited.

**Competitor Classifications:** This is a classified match and will be conducted using the current NRA High Power Rifle classification system in all matches. Any individual or team may elect,

before firing, to compete in a higher classification than the one in which classified. Such individual or team must fire in the higher class throughout the tournament. In the event of insufficient entries in any class to warrant an award in that class individuals or teams will be moved to a higher class. International competitors without NRA USA classification will compete in the highest classification.

**Challenge Fees:** Challenge fees will be \$1.00.

**Ammunition:** Individuals must provide their own ammunition. Any safe ammunition is allowed.

**Squadding:** All matches will be squadded by the Chief Statistical Officer and packets will be available by 4:00 pm on September 29, 2008.

**Rules:** Current NRA rules and F-Class rules will be in effect. Rule 9.1, as it pertains to changing rifles, does not apply in this match.

**Rifle Classification:**

There will be two classes of rifles recognized:

F/O (F-Class Open): Maximum rifle weight 22 pounds.

F/TR (F-Class Target Rifle): 223-Rem. or 308-Win caliber rifle fired from a Bi-pod. A rear rest (sandbag or sock) is permitted. Maximum rifle weight is 18.15 pounds.

1. **\*\*Note:** Muzzle brakes and rifles over 35 caliber are not allowed.
2. **\*\*Note:** For details on current F-Class rifle and equipment rules see NRA High Power Rule Book.

**Targets:**

Targets used in this match will be the new NRA LR-FC, and NRA MR-FC.

**Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI):** *Safety is paramount!* Rifles will have actions open, magazines removed, and an **ECI** inserted into the chamber at **ALL** times except--when on the firing line during the preparation period or during live firing. ECIs will be available for purchase on the range for \$1.00.

**Coaching:** Coaching during the score/record portion of individual matches is not allowed. Coaching is allowed only during the sighting period of the match and in team matches. There will be a spotting scope available on the firing line to assist competitors in getting on target if necessary.

**TARGET SERVICE (TENTATIVE):** Competitors will pull targets unless Winnequah Gun Club can provide target pullers.

**Scoring:** Competitors will score. Individuals failing to perform the required scoring duties may be disqualified.

**Awards:** The award schedule will be posted at the match. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 individuals or 3 teams to qualify for awards. Awards will be given in Individual and Team matches, daily aggregate and Grand Aggregate for both Open and FTR. Appropriate cash awards will be given based on number of competitors (approximately 45% of gross match

income).

**MONDAY SEPTEMBER 29, 2008 – firing time 9:00 am**

**Open practice** at 600, 1000 and 1200 yds; 20 minutes per relay.

**TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 30, 2008 – firing time 8:00 am**

**Squadded Warm-up Match:** 600 yd (20 minutes), 1000 yd (25 minutes), 1200 yds (25 minutes), unlimited sighters at each yard line and 15 rounds for record; awards will be given.

**WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 1, 2008 – U.S. F-Class Nationals start (firing time 8:00 am)**

**Four person Team Match – firing time 8:00 am:** 600 yd slow fire prone: 2 sighters and 20 rounds for record per team member. Time limit will be 43 minutes per 2 member phase. A pit change will occur between phases. NRA MR-FC target.

**Four person Team Match:** 1000 yd slow fire prone: 2 sighters and 20 rounds for record per team member. Time limit will be 63 minutes per 2 member phase. A pit change will occur between phases. NRA LR-FC target.

An Individual practice, on a space available basis, will be run along with the Team Matches.

**THURSDAY OCTOBER 2, 2008 F-CLASS - 600 YD PHASE OF THE NATIONAL CHAMP.**

**Match 1:** 600 yd individual slow fire prone. Unlimited sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 17 minutes. **(firing time 8:00 am)**

**Match 2:** 600 yd individual slow fire prone. 2 sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 17 minutes.

**Match 3:** 600 yd individual slow fire prone. 2 sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 17 minutes.

**Match 4:** 600 yd Aggregate (total of Matches 1,2,3).

**FRIDAY OCTOBER 3, 2008 F-CLASS - 1000 YD PHASE 1 OF THE NATIONAL CHAMP.**

**Match 5:** 1000 yd individual slow fire prone. Unlimited sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 22 minutes. **(firing time 8:00 am)**

**Match 6:** 1000 yd individual slow fire prone. 2 sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 22 minutes.

**Match 7:** 1000 yd individual slow fire prone. 2 sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 22 minutes.

**Match 8:** 1000 yd Aggregate (total of Matches 5,6,7).

**SATURDAY OCTOBER 4, 2008 F-CLASS - 1000 YD PHASE 2 OF THE NATIONAL CHAMP.**

**Match 9:** 1000 yd individual slow fire prone. Unlimited sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 22 minutes. **(firing time 8:00 am)**

**Match 10:** 1000 yd individual slow fire prone. 2 sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 22 minutes.

**Match 11:** 1000 yd individual slow fire prone. 2 sighters and 15 rounds for record in a time limit of 22 minutes.

**Match 12:** 1000 yd Aggregate (total of Matches 9,10,11).

**Procedure for clearing the firing line:**

At no time is anyone to leave the firing line with a loaded rifle! All competitors are to be responsible for safe rifles while on the firing line. At no time should a competitor get out of position without the Empty Chamber Indicator being placed in the empty chamber and the competitor's scorekeeper verifies that fact. Penalty for breaking this rule is disqualification from the match for both the competitor and scorekeeper. Anyone who fires a shot during the preparation period will be scored a miss for the first record shot of that match. Anyone that fires a shot prior to the preparation period or any other nonfiring period will be disqualified from any further competition.

**Additional information:**

**Competitors who attended the 2007 F Class National Championship match in Raton New Mexico will have first priority until March 1, 2008.** After March 1 entries will be on a first-come basis. The program is on the WGC web site at [www.WinGunClub.org](http://www.WinGunClub.org) and [www.WRPA.com](http://www.WRPA.com), and will be mailed after January 6, 2008. For those competitors who plan to fly into Wisconsin the nearest airport is Madison, approximately 25-30 miles from the range. The next airport is Milwaukee which is about 80-85 miles.

Any equipment or other gear can be shipped to us before the match. Please make sure the shipment arrives **NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 24, 2008**. Mailing address is 10890 Summit Ridge Dr, Viola WI 54664. We will have our cell phone at the range from Sept. 26 to Oct. 5 – number is 608-625-6005.

A swap meet is tentatively scheduled for Thursday Oct. 2 after completion of the match. Tables will be available for anyone who wishes to use them. The swap meet will be at the picnic shelter (weather permitting), or new Indoor Range.

A pig roast and Awards Ceremony will be held on Saturday Oct. 4, time to be announced. There will be a \$10.00 charge for the pig roast.

The Eau Claire Rifle Club located outside of Eau Claire WI will be holding a 4-gun 600 yard match on Saturday, Sept. 27, and an 80 shot across the course match on Sunday, Sept. 28.
